Dreams as an Indicator of the Psychoanalytic Treatment Process

Paul Steinberg, MD, FRCP

The literature relating dreams to psychoanalytic process will be reviewed. Subsequently the history of an ongoing treatment will be presented, with an emphasis on dreams as they relate to the process of treatment, including the vicissitudes of the transference and countertransference. Different aspects and types of dreams will be considered, including the first dream, termination dreams, mirror dreams, the manifest dream, counter-transference dreams, successive dreams, and changes in dream affect.

Paul Steinberg completed his medical training at the University of Toronto and his psychiatric training at the Universities of Toronto and Western Ontario. He is a clinical professor and psychodynamic psychotherapy clinical coordinator, Department of Psychiatry, University of British Columbia. His past positions include: clinical professor and psychotherapy program director at the University of Alberta in Edmonton, clinical coordinator of the Psychiatric Day Treatment Program at the same, and director of the Psychodynamic Psychiatry Service at University of Alberta Hospital. Dr. Steinberg is a graduate of the National Training Program in Contemporary Psychoanalysis of the National Institute for the Psychotherapies in New York. He maintains a private practice in psychotherapy and psychoanalysis in Vancouver. Recent publications include articles on threats of violence in group psychotherapy, learning within psychotherapy supervision, structured groups in psychiatric day treatment, and projective identification in group psychotherapy. He is the coauthor of a book chapter on psychodynamic day treatment of patients with personality disorders.
